Woodland Wonder Summer Care



Woodland Wonder's 10 weeks of summer care is designed for students entering grades Prekindergarten 3 through grade 4.

Summer care runs Monday through Friday weekly beginning June 16th and ending on August 22nd. (There is no summer care on July 4th.)

- Summer Care begins at 9:00 am until 3:00 pm. Early drop-off is available beginning at 7:30 am with a \$6.00/hour rate. There is also aftercare available until 5:00 pm with a \$6.00/hour rate.
- Summer care children bring their own lunch and drink. A snack in the am and pm will be provided.
- Cost is \$170.00 per week.
Price includes snacks and summer care T-Shirt.
(\$135.00 for week of July 4th)
- A 10% discount is offered to children attending 2 weeks or more. **An additional 10% discount is afforded to contracted Woodland students attending two or more weeks who enroll by May 30th.**
- Summer care days begin in the classroom with lessons to strengthen academic skills and reinforce key age-appropriate concepts of learning. These lessons are then followed by a block of themed morning fun. Children will have lunch and then find themselves back in the classroom for additional academic reinforcement. The day will end with a block of themed afternoon fun.



Please note: the weekly schedule is subject to change without notice. Summer care is contingent upon enough participation and can be cancelled by the Head of School at his sole discretion.

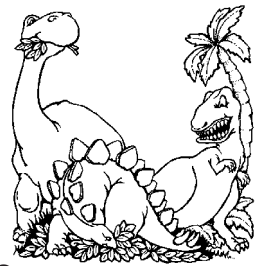
PM Fun: Isn't it Beachy!
